Monday, January 20 FRESH FILLING OF THE SPIRIT

- ◆ Our families will be filled with joy, not criticism or grumbling.

- ◆ TCC will sacrificially serve the community with joy, bringing healing, deliverance and salvation to individuals and families.

Thursday, January 23 PEACE

- ◆ We will not worry & bring our requests to God with thanksgiving.
- ◆ We will make every effort to do what leads to peace and submit to one another out of reverence for Christ in our families.
- ◆ Our church family will strive to live at peace with one another.
- ◆ We will be ambassadors of peace in our workplaces, neighborhoods, and communities.

Friday, January 24 PATIENCE

And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. Galatians 6:9

- ◆ We would believe that God is good and has a good plan for us.
- ◆ We would be patient and not exasperate members of our family.
- ◆ We will not stir up conflict but calm quarrels in our church family.
- ◆ We will be patient with those who are struggling around us.

Saturday, January 25 KINDNESS

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Colossians 3:9

- ◆ We would understand God's grace and kindness toward us.
- ◆ Kindness would be a hallmark of our families.
- ◆ We would be kind to one another, tender-hearted and forgiving.
- ◆ We will be showing "unusual kindness" and hospitality to others.

Sunday, January 26 GOODNESS

I myself am convinced, my brothers and sisters, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with knowledge and competent to instruct one another. Romans 15:14

- ◆ We would do good to our enemies.
- ◆ Our families would recognize and proclaim the goodness of God.
- ◆ We would overcome evil with good.
- ◆ Goodness and mercy would follow us wherever we go.

Monday, January 27 FAITHFULNESS

Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much... Luke 16:10

- ◆ We will remain faithful to God under hardship.
- ◆ Our family relationships would be characterized by faithfulness.
- ◆ Our teaching and behaviors would be faithful to the Word of God.
- ◆ We would be faithful in small things and a mighty force for God.

Tuesday, January 28 GENTLENESS

A gentle answer turns away wrath... Proverbs 15:1

- ◆ We would know Christ as the good shepherd who leads us.
- ◆ We would respond in our families with gentleness, not frustration.
- ◆ Our conversations would be full of grace seasoned with salt.
- ◆ We would gently give answers for the hope we have in Christ.

Wednesday, January 29 SELF-CONTROL

- ◆ God would give us a spirit of love, power, and self-control.
- ◆ Our families would act in wisdom and moderation in all things.
- ◆ TCC would be sober, awake, and alert to the enemy in these days.
- ◆ TCC would be characterized by the fear of the Lord in all things.

Thursday, January 30 UNITY OF THE SPIRIT

Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:3
